## WHATEVER YOU CALL THEM, DON'T CALL THEM SAFE.

Vaporizers. Cloud pens. E-hookahs. E-cigarettes. Vaping devices go by many names. What you call them doesn't matter.

What matters is they can fill your lungs with carcinogens, and they're illegal if you're under 21.



## IF YOU CAN'T PRONOUNCE IT, DON'T VAPE IT.

You'd be surprised how many different chemicals have been found in vapor. Here's one: Rubidium. You might know it as the stuff that makes fireworks turn purple.



## DON'T BE A GUINEA PIG.

When tobacco cigarettes first came out, everyone thought they were pretty safe too. Whoops. Now we know better. Vaping hasn't been well-studied yet, so all we have is a question mark.

## SAFER DOESN'T MAKE IT SAFE.

People think vaping is “safer” than smoking. It's safe to say that doesn't mean it's safe.
